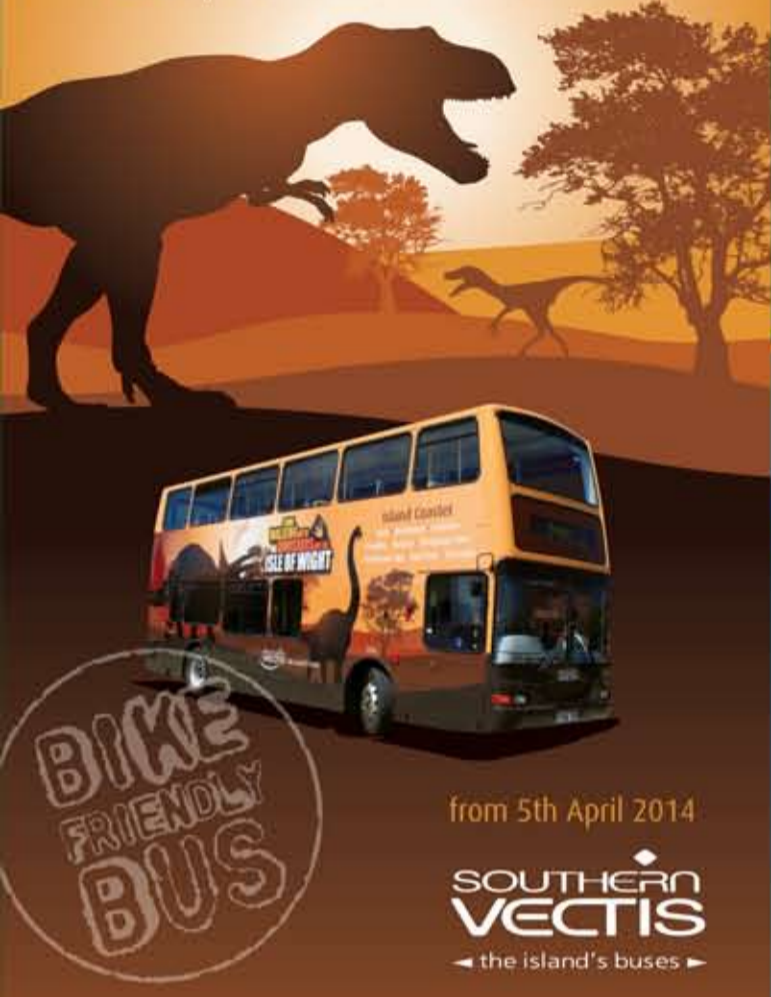

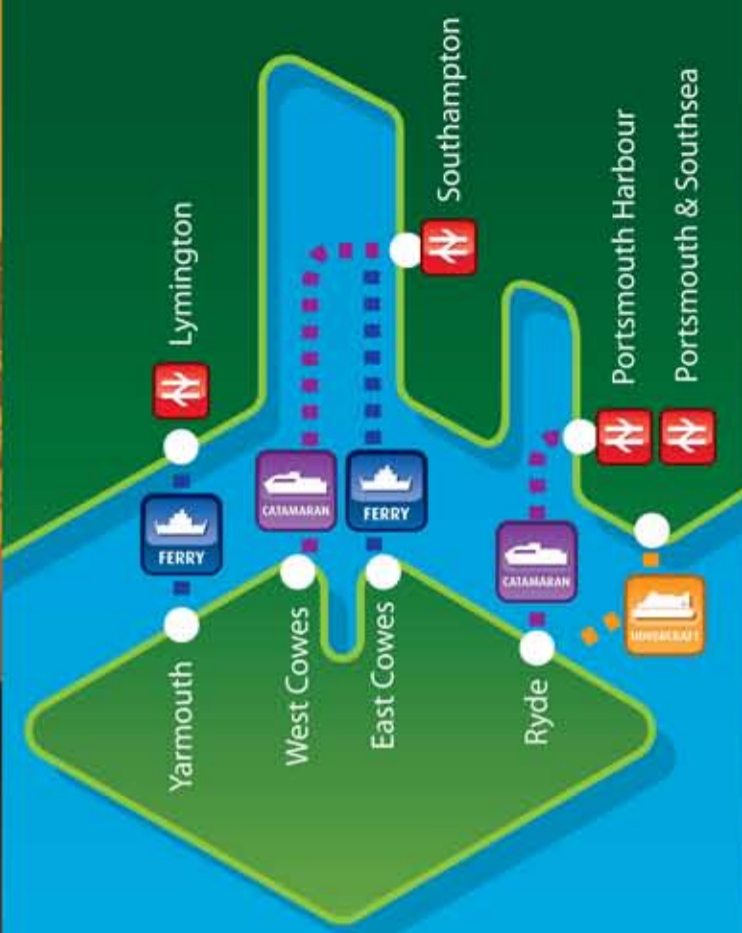

Getting to Ryde

Hovertravel's hovercraft runs mostly every 30 minutes from Southsea, and it's quick too – just 10 minutes to reach Ryde. If you're coming from Portsmouth city centre or the rail station, there's a frequent 'Hoverbus' shuttle direct to the Hoverport in Southsea.



Alternatively, Wightlink's catamaran leaves from Portsmouth Harbour station and runs up to every 30 minutes to Ryde Pier Head. Both routes are just a short walk to Ryde bus station from where the Island Coaster and our open-top Downs Breezer buses depart.



Getting to Yarmouth

The Wightlink ferry leaves Lymington up to every 40 minutes, with over 18 return journeys every day of the week. There are frequent trains to Lymington Pier from Brockenhurst, connecting with trains from London, Winchester and Southampton, also from Birmingham, the Midlands and the North.

It's just a 40 minute voyage across the Solent with lovely coastal scenery to enjoy. A couple of minutes walk at the other end and you're in the bus station where the Island Coaster and our open-top Needles Breezer buses depart.



You can also get to and from the Island from Southampton to Cowes by Red Funnel's Red Jet or East Cowes by their car ferry or to Fishbourne from Portsmouth on Wightlink's car ferry.



Use our frequent buses via Newport to get to Ryde or Yarmouth for a great family day out exploring even more of the Island.

Go to the iTunes store and search for "Dinosaur Island Isle of Wight" then click "install" to upload the app to your phone.

- £10** adult
- £5** under 19s and over 60s
over 60s tickets can only be bought and used on breezer and island coaster buses.
- £25** group up to any 5 people

Your ticket lasts 24 hours from the time of purchase and allows travel on any of our buses or Breezer open top bus rides - hop on and hop off as often as you like. Buy your ticket from the driver of the first bus you get on. Rover and Freedom tickets and Key cards are accepted on the Island Coaster and local fares are available on the bus. Concessionary passes are not accepted.

COME WALKING WITH DINOSAURS ON THE ISLE OF WIGHT

There are six meteorites situated on the route. At each location you will meet a different dinosaur.



When you arrive at one of the meteorites, open your phone app* or tablet and point the camera lens at the white square. Keep your camera level with the square for a few seconds to get the best results.

The meteors are mainly located near the bus route, but the bus does not stop or wait at the meteors themselves - some walking may be necessary.

Look out for our timetable book & other leaflets which give details of our great open-top Breezer buses - the Needles Breezer, one of the most spectacular bus rides in England & the Downs Breezer.

Sandown

ISLE OF WIGHT ZOO

The Isle of Wight Zoo is a family-run zoo with a special interest in tigers and lemurs. The zoo was built within the ruins of a Victorian Fort built to guard Sandown's coast. A great venue for all the family - you can even be a zookeeper for the day!

DINOSAUR ISLE

Take a walk back through time from the Ice Age to the recent past, back to the Cretaceous period when dinosaurs lived - see life sized reconstructions of dinosaurs, real fossils and animatronic dinosaurs!

Blackgang Chine

Overlooking the spectacular South West Heritage Coast of the Island, Blackgang Chine Fantasy Park is an eccentric mix of exciting rides, goblins and fairies, dinosaurs, nursery rhyme characters, cowboys and Indians.

Seaview

Seaview Wildlife really stands out from the crowd! Getting mobbed by Wallabies and Meerkats might send some people running but animal enthusiasts will be in seventh heaven, in absolute style at this multi-award winning attraction.

Situated in a stunning parkland setting with fabulous sea views this hidden gem has a special ambience and charm and offers all guests a warm and friendly interactive wildlife experience.

The focus is on involvement so visitors are encouraged to stay for the day and join in with the nine daily hands-on keeper led events with the extra option of exclusive behind the scenes V.I.P. Encounters. This is a Wildlife extravaganza not to be missed.
