Job Purpose

Help deliver excellent customer service by maintaining company vehicles to the standard required by the Company, Department of Transport and VOSA in order to achieve maximum vehicle availability. To be responsible for working in a safe manner as stated in current legislation and company policies and procedures, at all times.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. The inspection, diagnosis, maintenance and repair of all company vehicles including buses, vans and coaches
2. Work effectively unsupervised and often with only an outline brief, using specialist or practical skills to complete a timely solution
3. Receive, handle safely, store or deploy materials appropriate to the task being undertaken
4. Diagnose vehicle faults, using the relevant diagnostic equipment
5. Road test Company vehicles (licence permitting)
6. Supply own hand tools and take responsibility for specialist tools, materials etc that are used and observe a duty of care for all other items within the department
7. Ensure that all appropriate documentation and records are maintained accurately in order to satisfy the requirements of the Department of Transport and Company policies and procedures
8. Provide reports in relation to work and equipment as required
9. Keep abreast of technical developments through training and be willing to undertake continued professional development with regards to technical & personal skills
10. Ensure that all work is carried out in accordance with the Company's risk assessment practices and Health & Safety Policy requirements.
11. At all times be an ambassador of Oxford Bus Company and bus use in general

12. Operate in line with the Company vision and values and encourage others to do the same

13. Undertake any other duties and responsibilities of a similar nature or level of responsibility which may be allocated from time to time

The above duties and responsibilities must be carried out in compliance with the Company's Equal Opportunities, Diversity, Inclusion and Dignity at work Policy, the Health and Safety Policy and will all other Company Policies currently in force at Oxford Bus Company.

The role will involve working with onsite colleagues, customers, and contractors. This job description sets out the main duties of the post; however the list is not exhaustive.

Duties may vary from time to time as a result of new legislation, changes in technology or policy. In this event, appropriate training will be provided.

Economic conditions

Hourly rate for nights is £19.44, working a 37-hour week, over 5 lates with some flexibility as necessary. Normal hours are Monday to Thursday from 20.00hrs to 04.00hrs and Friday from 20.00hrs to 03.30hrs. Free bus travel, contributory pension, 25 days holiday plus 8 public holidays per annum (pro-rata according to the shift), lifestyle benefits, and employee assistance programme
