

SPECIFIC SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS

Version 2. What's changed? Litcham High School information. Carbrooke-Wayland Academy relief bus withdrawn. 0740 6 from Watton to Norwich relief bus added.

In general there are currently social distancing rules in place on public transport meaning that only about half of the normal bus capacity can be used. Where only two or three pupils from a school travel on a bus then they should observe the usual social distancing rules, although they can sit together if they are in the same education bubble. However, where large numbers of children are travelling on buses to the same school the rules are slightly different:-

LITCHAM HIGH SCHOOL

Route 20 from/to Swaffham and Great Massingham will have a zone upstairs for Litcham High School students. The lower deck will be for Dereham Schools' students.

From the front to the rear of the upper deck students should sit within their year groups starting with year 7 at the front, then year 8, year 9, year 10 and year 11 at the rear.

NEATHERD HIGH SCHOOL

Route 14 will only be available to students at Netherd High School. An additional students only route 8 will be provided from the school at 1547 – please use this bus if you are travelling back to Toftwood.

On route 4 to and from Swanton Morley, which will be open only to schoolchildren, Neatherd students should sit upstairs as there will be Northgate High pupils on this bus downstairs. The same applies on route 21A from North Elmham, although this will still be open to members of the public.

On route 20 to and from Great Massingham Neatherd students should sit on the lower deck of the bus at the rear and Sixth Form/Northgate High pupils should sit on the lower deck of the bus at the front. Litcham High School students will be upstairs.

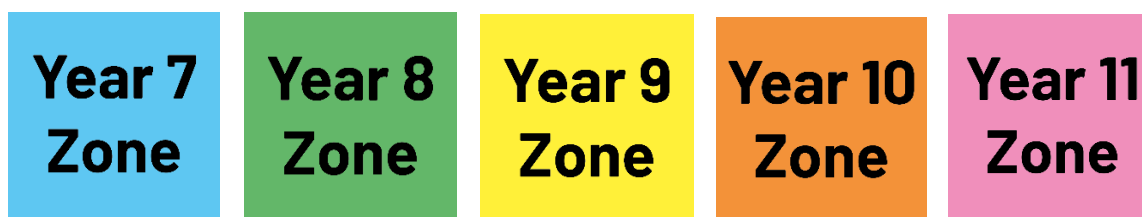
Students travelling on route 4 to and from Mattishall should avoid the adult zone at the front downstairs of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus.

Please follow the standard zoning guidelines on the buses:-

UPSTAIRS Front yr 9 Middle yr 10 Back yr 11

DOWNSTAIRS Front yr 7 Rear yr 8

These zones will be indicated by the coloured stickers displayed around the bus – try and leave a row of seats between zones if there is space.



NORTHGATE HIGH SCHOOL

On route 4 to and from Swanton Morley, which will be open to school children only, Northgate students should sit downstairs as there will be Neatherd pupils on this bus upstairs. Older pupils should sit at the

back of the bus. The same applies on route 21A from North Elmham, although this will be open to members of the public.

On route 20 to and from Massingham Northgate students should sit at the front of the bus as there will be Neatherd pupils at the rear of the bus. Older pupils should sit at the back of the bus.

Students travelling on route 11/11A to and from Watton and Toftwood and on route 21A should avoid the adult zone at the front downstairs of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus.

In the afternoon route 11A will only be available to Northgate High School pupils.

Please follow the standard zoning guidelines on the buses where Northgate pupils are the only users of the bus:-

UPSTAIRS Front yr 9 Middle yr 10 Back yr 11

DOWNSTAIRS Front yr 7 Rear yr 8

These zones will be indicated by the coloured stickers displayed around the bus – try and leave a row of seats between zones if there is space.



BROADLAND HIGH SCHOOL, WROXHAM

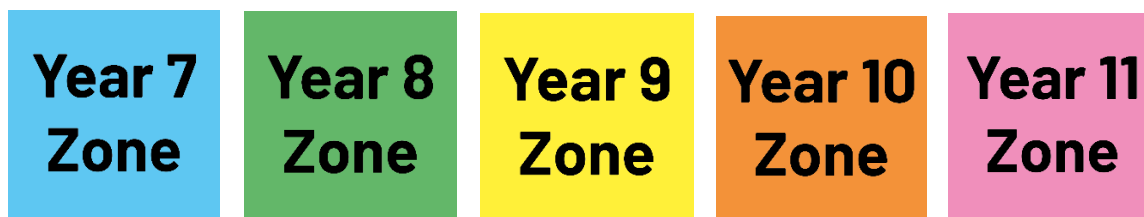
Route 53C will only be available to students at Broadland High School.

Please follow the zoning guidelines on the buses:-

UPSTAIRS Front yr 9 Middle yr 10 Back yr 11

DOWNSTAIRS Front yr 7 Rear yr 8

These zones will be indicated by the coloured stickers displayed around the bus – try and leave a row of seats between zones if there is space.



WAYLAND ACADEMY, WATTON

Students using :-

- route 11 from Swaffham and Necton
- route 3 from Barford, Hingham and Carbrooke

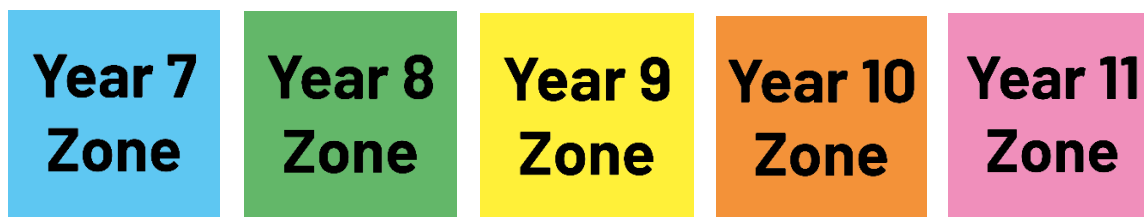
should avoid the adult zone at the front downstairs of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus. An extra bus will be provided for Wayland Academy students from Carbrooke in the morning, please use that bus if it serves your stop – from 21/9/20 this will be removed following low usage and spare capacity on the main bus which is a double decker.

Please follow the zoning guidelines on the buses:-

UPSTAIRS Front yr 9 Middle yr 10 Back yr 11

DOWNSTAIRS Front yr 7 Rear yr 8

These zones will be indicated by the coloured stickers displayed around the bus – try and leave a row of seats between zones if there is space.



FRAMLINGHAM EARL HIGH SCHOOL

Students using route 84 should avoid the adult zone at the front of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus.

Older children should sit at the back of the bus.

HETHERSETT ACADEMY & WYMONDHAM ACADEMY

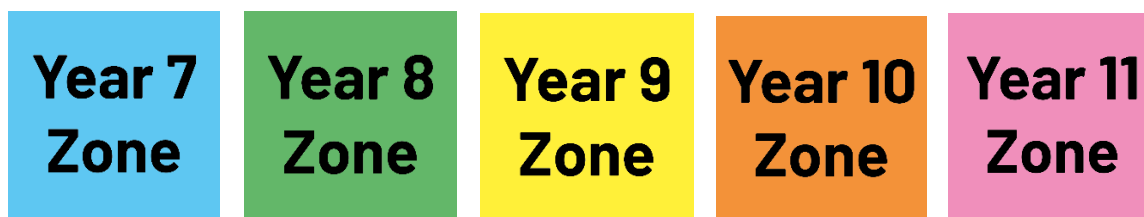
When using route 6 please avoid the adult zone at the front downstairs of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus

UPSTAIRS Front yr 9 Middle yr 10 Back yr 11

DOWNSTAIRS Front yr 7 Rear yr 8

These zones will be indicated by the coloured stickers displayed around the bus – try and leave a row of seats between zones if there is space.



CITY COLLEGE, NORWICH

We carry a large number of students into the centre of Norwich. Most users purchase tickets directly from us and we are not aware of the school/college to which they belong.

We ask that students from the same school/college sit together on public buses. In particular we ask for sixth-formers to sit upstairs alongside other students from their college and in their year group.

In order to increase the amount of space available, and in order accommodate other members of the public safely on public service buses we will be providing some larger and additional buses.

We expect the following journeys into and out of Norwich to be particularly busy :-

- Route 3 – 0710 Watton High Street to Norwich
- Route 6 – 0740 Watton High Street to Norwich
- 1530 & 1635 Norwich to Watton

Route 5B – 1715 Norwich to Wroxham

Route 8 – all journeys leaving Dereham Market Place between 0730 and 0900

From 21/9/20 a relief bus will operate on the 0740 route 6 from Watton to Norwich.
