

SPECIFIC SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS

STOUR VALLEY SCHOOL, CLARE

Students using route 236 from Glemsford and Cavendish should avoid the adult zone at the front downstairs of the bus in order to allow sufficient space for the small number of adult passengers to remain socially distanced at the front of the bus.

Route 237 will only be available to students at Stour Valley School.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ROUTE 237 WILL RUN TO A NEW TIMETABLE THIS YEAR. BUS PASSES WITH 237 ON THEM CANNOT BE USED ON ROUTE 236.

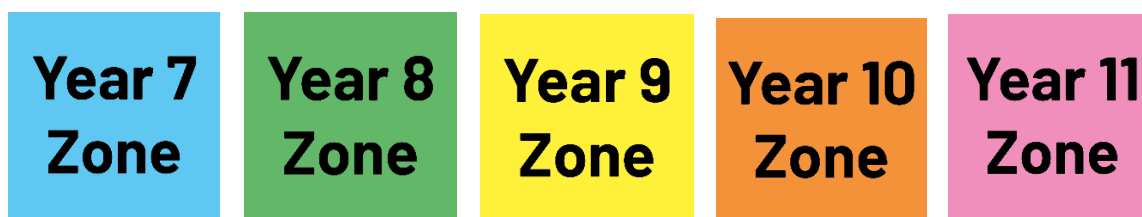

COLCHESTER SIXTH FORM COLLEGE/INSTITUTE

NORMAN WAY SCHOOLS

We carry a large number of students into the centre of Colchester. Most users purchase tickets directly from us and we are not aware of the school/college to which they belong.

We ask that students from the same school/college sit together on public buses. In particular we ask for sixth-formers to sit upstairs alongside other students from their college and in their year group.

In order to increase the amount of space available, and in order accommodate other members of the public safely on public service buses we will be providing some larger and additional buses.

We expect the following journeys into and out of Colchester to be particularly busy and plan to provide extra seats as follows:-

Routes 84 and 756

756 - 0715 Sudbury to Norman Way Schools and 1554 Norman Way Schools to Sudbury

84 – 0657 Sudbury to Norman Way Schools and 1550 Norman Way Schools to Sudbury

An additional relief bus will probably be provided (please check our website for updates) from Sudbury, Great Cornard, Nayland Turning, Great Horkeley and Mile End for Colchester Sixth Form students only. Please use this additional single-deck bus if you attend Colchester Sixth Form to allow more space on the normal double-deckers for school groups sitting together and our small number of regular adult passengers socially distanced at the front downstairs.

BURY SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES

We carry a large number of students into Bury. Many users purchase tickets directly from us and we are not aware of the school/college to which they belong.

We ask that students from the same school/college sit together on public buses. In particular we ask for sixth-formers to sit upstairs alongside other students from their college and in their year group.

In order to increase the amount of space available, and in order accommodate other members of the public safely on public service buses we will be setting aside the first four rows of seats on the lower deck to provide a socially distanced space for other passengers.

1.Travelling from the direction of Clare and Glemsford

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TIMETABLE HAS CHANGED SINCE THE SCHOOLS WERE LAST IN SESSION.

Route 373 is reserved for schoolchildren only. Horringer Court and King Edwards pupils should sit downstairs and St Benedict's and County Upper and Abbeygate pupils should sit upstairs.

Route 374 0730 from Clare will mainly be occupied by West Suffolk College students, but there will be a socially distanced zone at the front downstairs for other passengers.

2.Travelling from the direction of Sudbury (see next page)

Route 751 is reserved for school and college pupils only. King Edwards pupils should sit at the front of the bus and West Suffolk College students should sit at the back.

Routes 752 and 753 (0653 from Bures) will mainly be occupied by West Suffolk College students, but there will be a socially distanced zone at the front downstairs for other passengers.

Students must sit in the correct zones and not mix with students from other year groups.
